**In Phlebotomy class learn to:** draw blood specimens from patients for the purpose of testing and analyzing blood. Practice procedures and patient care in college lab prior to clinical experiences. Class, lab, and clinicals are required. Successful course completion qualifies you to take National Certification Exam (GED required for national exam). Placement testing required to register (Reading 12.9 & Math 8.0). Insurance: \$18 Course fee: \$65; Total \$83 

## TABE Test Information

The required TABE placement testing is available in the Academic Studies Center, Hurst Continuing Education Building, Room 200. Picture ID is required to test. No appointment is needed. Testing is free of charge. Center hours are the following: Monday-Thursday, 7:30am-6pm; Friday, 7:30am-2pm.

## Additional Requirements

Successful completion of a background check (est. \$30), a drug screening (est. \$35), and several immunizations (costs vary) are also required during the class. For further information call (910) 938-6294.

# Coastal Carolina Community College Phlebotomy Agreement to Terms

## **General**

1. Pay Registration Fee (\$65) and non-refundable insurance fee (\$18) (\$83 total) if you are a primary enrollee.
2. Alternates must wait to be admitted to class and pay the nonrefundable insurance fee the day they join class.

## **Agreement**

I understand I must attend the first six weeks of class:

Monday through Thursday nights from 4 - 8 pm. For the next six weeks of class, I must be available to attend clinical training Monday through Friday during the day in 4 and 5 hour blocks as shown below. Three weeks will be at Onslow Memorial Hospital (OMH) and the other three weeks will be at Naval Hospital Camp Lejeune (NHCL). Clinical schedules cannot be arranged until the first class session.

Onslow Memorial: Morning 7am – 12pm , Afternoon 1pm – 6pm

Naval Hospital: Morning 7:30am – 11:30am, Afternoon 11am – 3pm

Attend the final week of class for keyboarding and workplace ethics training.

## **Before the first class:**

I must purchase (available at Coastal Bookstore) Text: \$53 plus tax = \$56.58 (30 day return policy – w/the receipt - the text cannot be written in and CDs/software cannot be opened)

Disposable Lab Coat w/cuffs (approx \$6.00) NOTE: Continuing Education Phlebotomy students usually purchase the blue lab coats.

I will not purchase the below items or services until I receive specific instructions from my instructor. I am aware in order to attend clinical training which begins 6 weeks into class that I must have paid for and, if applicable, successfully passed:

Satisfactory results for drug screening (estimate \$30)

Satisfactory criminal background history of prior 7 years completed\* (estimate \$30)\* If you have only lived in one county for the past (seven) 7 years, you may purchase a background check from your county courthouse.

Scrubs (estimate \$50)

## **And provide my instructor with verification of the following shots:**

- PPD (TB skin test) within 1 year
- Rubella Titer (German measles) or proof of one rubella vaccine
- Rubella Titer (Red Measles) or proof of two measles immunizations after their first birthday (if born after 1956)
- Proof of three Hepatitis B vaccines or Hepatitis B surface antibody titer
- Mumps Titer or proof of 2 Mumps vaccines
- Varicella titer (Chicken Pox), if negative history of chickenpox;

Please determine your immunization costs early as they will vary based on your medical insurance and need.

Civilians may contact the Onslow County Health Department Immunization Clinic (347-2154) and make an appointment for the PPD, tetanus, and MMR shots if needed or contact a physician of your choice. Military dependents may contact the Naval Hospital Immunization Clinic (450-4648). Please take your immunization and medical records to the clinic.
